### HOW TO QUALIFY FOR THE SALT SPRING ISLAND \$100 LOW FLUSH TOILET REBATE

The Salt Spring Island (SSI) Low Flush Toilet Rebate is for toilet replacements in private residences, constructed prior to January 1, 2005, on Salt Spring Island. New construction or additions are not eligible. Rebates are limited to one toilet per residential property owner.

All toilets must be low flush with 6.0 litres/flush or less and CSA, Warnock Hersey or cUPC certified.

Applicants are responsible for ensuring they have all necessary building and/or plumbing permits. Only toilets purchased and installed after the start of this program are eligible for rebates.

## Water Savings Tips

### DID YOU KNOW...

- Older toilets use 13 to 20 litres of water per flush compared to 6 litres or less on new models.
- You can reduce unnecessary flushes by using the garbage can to dispose of tissues and other garbage and allowing multiple uses before flushing.
- Checking for leaks can save you between 20 to 40 litres of waters per hour! Remove the toilet tank lid and add a few drops of food colouring into the tank water. If your toilet bowl changes colour, too, it is time for toilet repairs.
- Repairing a toilet handle that jams will also prevent water from running continuously and being wasted.



- Monitoring your water bill for high use can also help you discover leaks. Plus, you can challenge yourself to lower the amount you use before the next bill arrives!

### HOW TO QUALIFY FOR AN EXTRA \$65 LOW FLUSH TOILET REBATE AND UP TO \$5000 IN OTHER RETROFIT GRANTS

NOTE: A home energy assessment is not required to receive the SSI \$100 Low Flush Toilet Rebate.

1. To access an additional \$65 toilet rebate and other retrofit grants, book a home energy assessment **BEFORE** you install the toilet or start other home renovations. Receive a customized retrofit plan from a City Green Advisor. Cost \$150\*
2. Install a selection of grant-eligible products listed at [www.citygreen.ca](http://www.citygreen.ca)
3. Book a follow-up energy assessment: A City Green Advisor will re-assess your home and complete your grant application for you. Cost \$150\*
4. Receive a grant cheque from the ecoENERGY Retrofit - Homes Program, Natural Resources Canada.

*In one part of the home energy assessment, a City Green Certified Energy Advisor uses a blower door fan test to find and measure the home's total air leakage.*
